## BURN PERMITS NOTICE

As most of you know, we do have a burning ordinance in Kimball Township. You can pick up the ordinance when you come in to get your burn permits. You must have a burn permit when burning trees, logs, brush, stumps, leaves and grass clippings. Anyone who violates any of the provisions of Ordinance Number 168-C, or fails to comply with duly authorized order issued pursuant to this ordinance, shall be deemed responsible of a municipal civil infraction.

As always, our burn permits are \$15.00 and are good for the whole year. January 1st to December 31st.

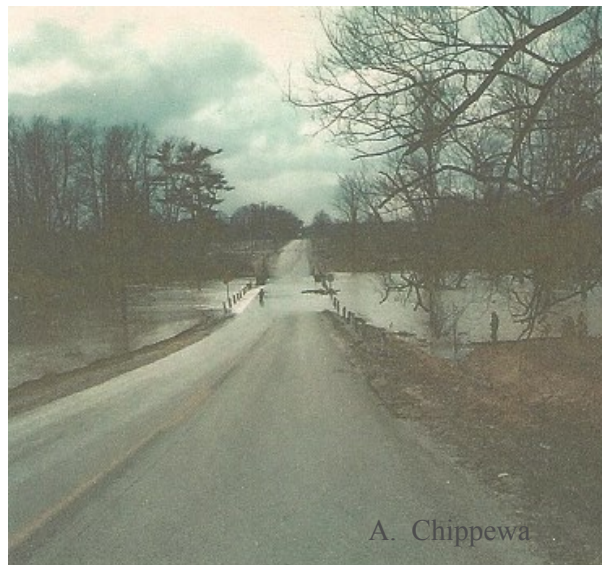
